Over the last four weeks, we have learned what it means to be **found faithful in little things, faithful with much, and faithful with all God has given us**. This theme comes from Paul's challenging words:

*Think of us in this way, as servants of Christ and stewards of God's mysteries. Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy.*

I Corinthians 4: 1-2

God can take little things in our lives, things that seem relatively insignificant, and multiply their impact beyond what we could have imagined. **What gifts are we holding back because we think they are "too little" to be of any use?** God can multiply even our smallest gifts in ways that allow good things to happen and people to be restored.

We are richly blessed. **How does God call us to be faithful with much – with all of our generous blessings?** Allow God to remind you how God has been faithful to our congregation and to challenge you to be faithful too.

**In what new ways is God calling our congregation to be generous?** When we trust God with all we have, miracles are possible. And yes, the reward of work well done is often more work and more trust. But a deeper engagement with Christ makes it well worth the extra effort!

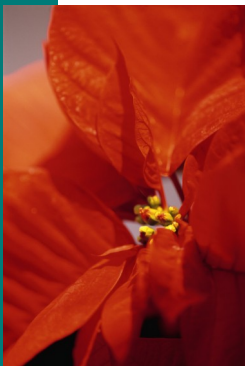
