Think of us in this way, as servants of Christ and stewards of God's mysteries. Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found trustworthy.

I Corinthians 4: 1-2

God can take little things in our lives, things that seem relatively insignificant, and multiply their impact beyond what we could have imagined. What gifts are we holding back because we think they are "too little" to be of any use? God can multiply even our smallest gifts in ways that allow good things to happen and people to be restored.

We are richly blessed. How does God call us to be faithful with much – with all of our generous blessings? Allow God to remind you how God has been faithful to our congregation and to challenge you to be faithful too.


