#### **Mission Commission: Angel Connection Coalition**



In December the Commission proposed to the CPC Council the creation of a coalition of churches to help support the Angel Connection, a faith-based food pantry in McCordsville, and received Council approval.

The coalition was formed by six of the 17 local churches invited to participate in an organizational meeting hosted by CPC on Feb 20; a steering committee was formed to assist Angel Connection and local churches enhance the food pantry's resources.

The Angel Connection was founded by Donna Foster, a local hairdresser, to help one family with young children at Christmas time. Donna and her clients and friends funded this effort by making voluntary \$1 contributions weekly throughout the year. As she became increasingly aware of the needs of hungry people in our McCordsville community, she took a leap of faith and founded Angel Connection in 2005.

Angel Connection has always struggled to meet the needs of the poor and hungry who found their way to the food pantry. As much as we — CPC or any other single church — might want to help, none of us can provide the level of support necessary to feed hungry folks in McCordsville by ourselves.

CPC has already been involved with Angel Connection. Last September Men of Christ helped rehab a portion of the exterior of the new building at 7739 N 600 W (right behind the CVS on Pendleton Pile), PW sponsored a mitten tree at Christmas and our youth has designated the proceeds of **Souper Bowl Sunday** (over \$1,000) to Angel Connection.

Our representative on the Angel Connection Coalition steering committee will be Brian King. In the next few weeks and months we will learn about new ways we can help Angel Connection become a more effective resource in McCordsville.
