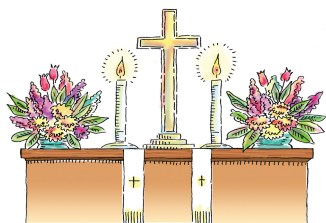
## TIME TO CELEBRATE!
