# US MILITARY ARMED FORCES



#### **Honoring our Veterans**

Armed Forces Day is the broad term used to describe holidays observed by nations around the world to honor their military forces. On August 31, 1949, Louis Johnson, who was the United States' Secretary of Defense, announced the creation of an Armed Forces Day to replace separate Army, Navy and Air Force Days. The event stemmed from the armed forces' unification under one department – the Department of Defense. Armed Forces Day, which is celebrated on the third Saturday in May, is part of Armed Forces Week. It was with the idea for citizens to come together and thank our military members for their patriotic service in support of our country that President Harry S Truman led the effort to establish this single holiday.

<u>Memorial Day</u> is an American holiday, observed on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military. ... Originally known as Decoration **Day**, it originated in the years following the Civil War and became an official federal holiday in 1971.

<u>Veterans Day</u> originated as "Armistice Day" on Nov. 11, 1919, the first anniversary of the end of World War I. Congress passed a resolution in 1926 for an annual observance, and Nov. 11 became a national holiday beginning in 1938. Memorial Day honors service members who died in service to their country or as a result of injuries incurred during

remembered on Veterans Day but the day is set aside to **thank** and honor living veterans who served honorably in the military - in wartime or peacetime. American troops made significant headway in 1918, rebuffing a German offensive along the western front and moving Allied forces deeper into enemy territory. By **November**, Germany had had enough. It agreed to a cease-fire, signing the **official armistice at 5 a.m. on November 11. The treaty took effect six hours later at 11 a.m. Hence** 

the phrase 11<sup>th</sup> month, 11<sup>th</sup> day, 11<sup>th</sup> hour.
