NEW Items for F.A.R.M. Food Drive (Fortville Area Resource 🛸 Mission)



F. A. R. M. is open every Tuesday from 12:30-2:30 for food pickup. They hold a Bible study from 11:30-12:30 prior to the pantry opening. On Thursdays they take food to a low income apartment complex on the north side of Fortville. They have 125 families at the pantry on Tuesdays and around 25 families in the apartments. They also sponsor snack bags for around 45 students in the Mt. Vernon school system to take home for the weekends.

During the next few months, we will be collecting "Celebration Kits" or "Holiday Kits". An assembled kit includes a 9"x13" cake pan WITH lid, a cake mix (any flavor), icing (appropriate for the cake), candles, napkins and plates.

Please bring to the church and place in grocery cart. They will be delivered to F.A.R.M..
