F.A.R.M. is currently in need of the following items to add to their shelves.

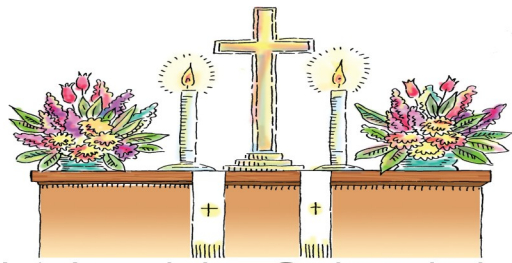
- Boxed potatoes, pasta, rice
