Lunch will be prepared by the King's and Wasitis's **Program: Ross & Beth King** will share their experiences on their recent trip on the Seine River in France!

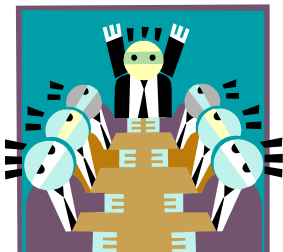

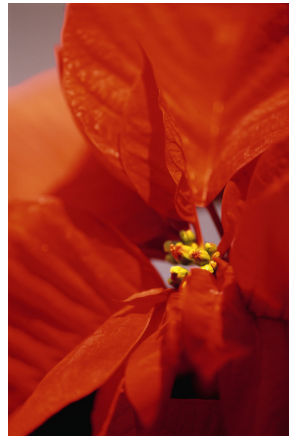
